Green Words

Decodable words containing the above sounds e.g ship, chop, wish, think, play, sleep, high, blow, spoon, book

Red Words - I of my to the no he be you your said

Maths (Numeracy)

Number Bonds to 10

Confidently use vocabulary of number bonds and addition.

Accurately identify pairs of numbers that total 10
Use a 10 frame and part whole model to represent.

Finding one more and one less

Recognise, understand and use the vocabulary linked to number bonds and finding one more and one less
Understand the structure of subtraction and finding a missing part.

Measure

Exploring length, height and time.
Ordering and sequencing time.
