

Dear Parents of Tigers class

We are delighted to let you know that as part of our history topic, learning about the Stone Age, Tigers class will be visiting Bishops Wood on Thursday 23rd October 2025. We will leave school at 9am and return for 3.20pm.

During the visit the children will have the opportunity to experience what it would have been like to live during the Stone Age. They will learn practical skills of the time, such as making hurdles and fishing nets, as well as how to build a shelter. This is an exciting opportunity for the children to engage with their learning in a practical way.

The children will need to wear school PE kit as we will be outside all day (long bottoms, a long-sleeve top, school PE jumper). They will also wear their school wellies which we will sort in the morning. Children will need to bring a packed lunch and a drink in a small bag/backpack. They must also bring a waterproof coat with a hood.

If your child is in receipt of Free School Meals then we can provide a packed lunch - please contact Mrs Bird in the office to request this.

The cost of the trip is £14.30. If your child receives Pupil Premium, the cost reduction is 50%, and so will be £7.15.

Payment and consent for this trip must be made on ParentPay by Friday 10th October 2025.
