

Dear Parents/Carers,

As part of our History learning, Tigers Class will be visiting Bishop's Wood Field Centre for the day on **Friday 8th November**. The visit will be during the school day and will return to school by 3:00pm.

The children will have the opportunity to experience what it was like to live in the Stone Age, linking to our Stone Age and Prehistoric History topic next half term. The children will discover first-hand what it was like to hunt and gather through a range of activities. They will learn practical skills of the time such as marking hurdles and fishing nets. They will also look at different types of rocks, tools of the period, how important fire and charcoal were and how fires were lit.

It will be a very hands-on day with lots of team work and problem solving!

We are also able to offer this trip at a reduced cost!

The cost of the trip is £16.00. Payment and consent for this trip should be made using ParentPay by Friday 18th October. If your child is entitled to Pupil Premium Funding (Income Based Free School Meals) school will fund 50% of the cost to parents. Payments for trips are requested on a voluntary basis, however if insufficient contributions are made, then unfortunately the trip may be cancelled.
