Dear Parents/Carers,

We have planned an exciting opportunity for Giraffes Class children to visit the Avoncroft Museum of Historic Buildings, based in Bromsgrove.

Children will have the chance to explore the numerous buildings, houses and homes from different stages in time, and also to learn more about the materials needed to construct buildings at various periods in history.

The activity workshop planned is entitled 'The Three Little Pigs'. The children will be involved in exploring building materials and construction techniques using straw, sticks, wood and bricks. This will link to our curriculum work in Science

The date of the visit is **Tuesday 16th April 2024**. All children will require a packed lunch either provided by you or pre-ordered through your ParentPay account. Children are expected to wear their school uniform jumper/cardigan plus other warm clothing suitable for the time of year. Strong/comfortable foot wear (lots of walking), is recommended and children must have a waterproof coat or jacket with them as the museum is exclusively an open-air site.

In order for this visit to take place, a voluntary donation of £14.50 per pupil is requested, which includes cost of the programme of activities at the museum and necessary transport. Payments are to be made via your ParentPay account and are to be received by Friday 12th April, 2024. If your child is entitled to Pupil Premium Funding (Income Based Free School Meals) school can help with 50% (£7.25) of the cost of this visit.
