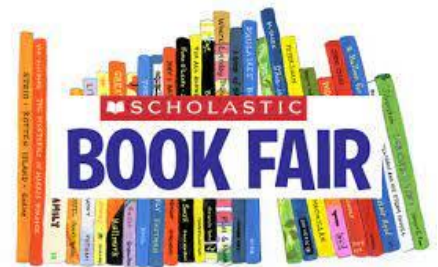
Scholastic Book Fair

World Book Day Competition:

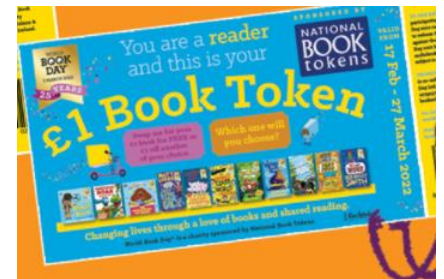
