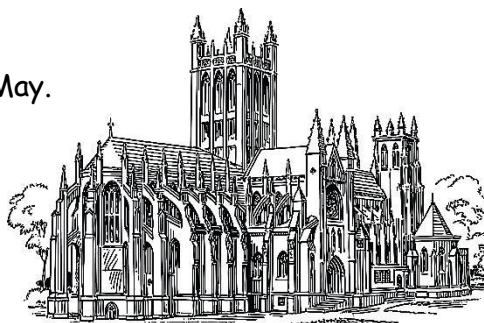
**"What kind of a world did Jesus want"?**
